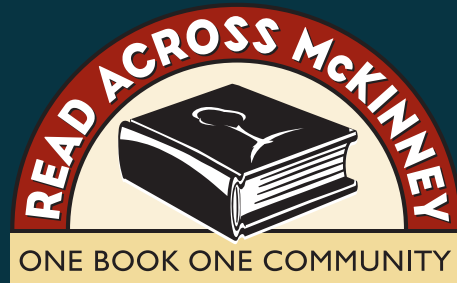

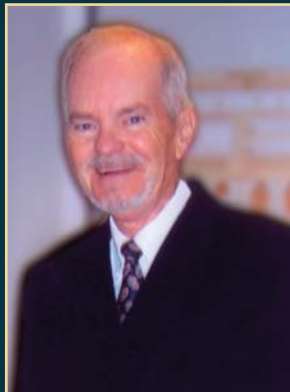
MEMBERSHIP
