

# Flying Friendly Over Collin County

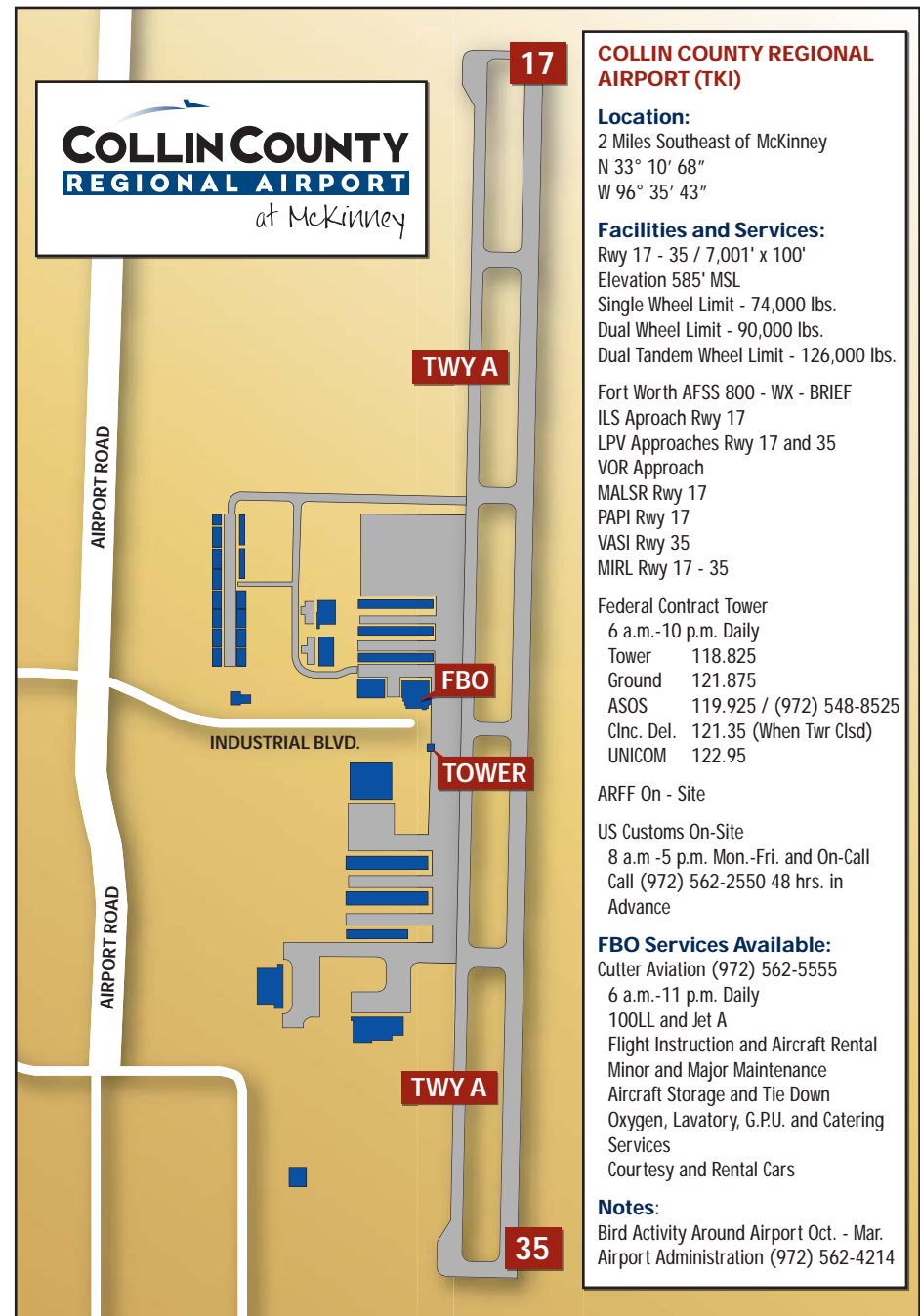
Collin County Regional Airport is an expanding general aviation facility committed to being a good neighbor to its surrounding communities by encouraging pilots to fly friendly. **The recommendations provided below are voluntary and should not be substituted for air traffic control instructions. Compliance with these recommendations is at the pilots discretion and should be done only when consistent with safety.**

## RECOMMENDED NOISE REDUCTION PROCEDURES

- i All aircraft should maintain a minimum altitude of 1,000-feet AGL whenever possible.
- i Rwy 17 is preferred when wind, weather and traffic permit.
- i Aircraft should use a left-hand traffic pattern for Rwy 17 and right-hand traffic pattern for Rwy 35.
- i For departures, use best rate of climb whenever possible.
- i Request propeller-driven aircraft use AOPA "Noise Awareness Steps" found on inside cover.
- i Jets departing Rwy 17 are asked to use the NBAA "Close-In" noise abatement procedure.
- i Suggest helicopters maintain traffic pattern altitude until necessary for landing, fly routes over public roadways and avoid residential areas.
- i Avoid the noise sensitive areas depicted on the inside cover whenever possible.
